

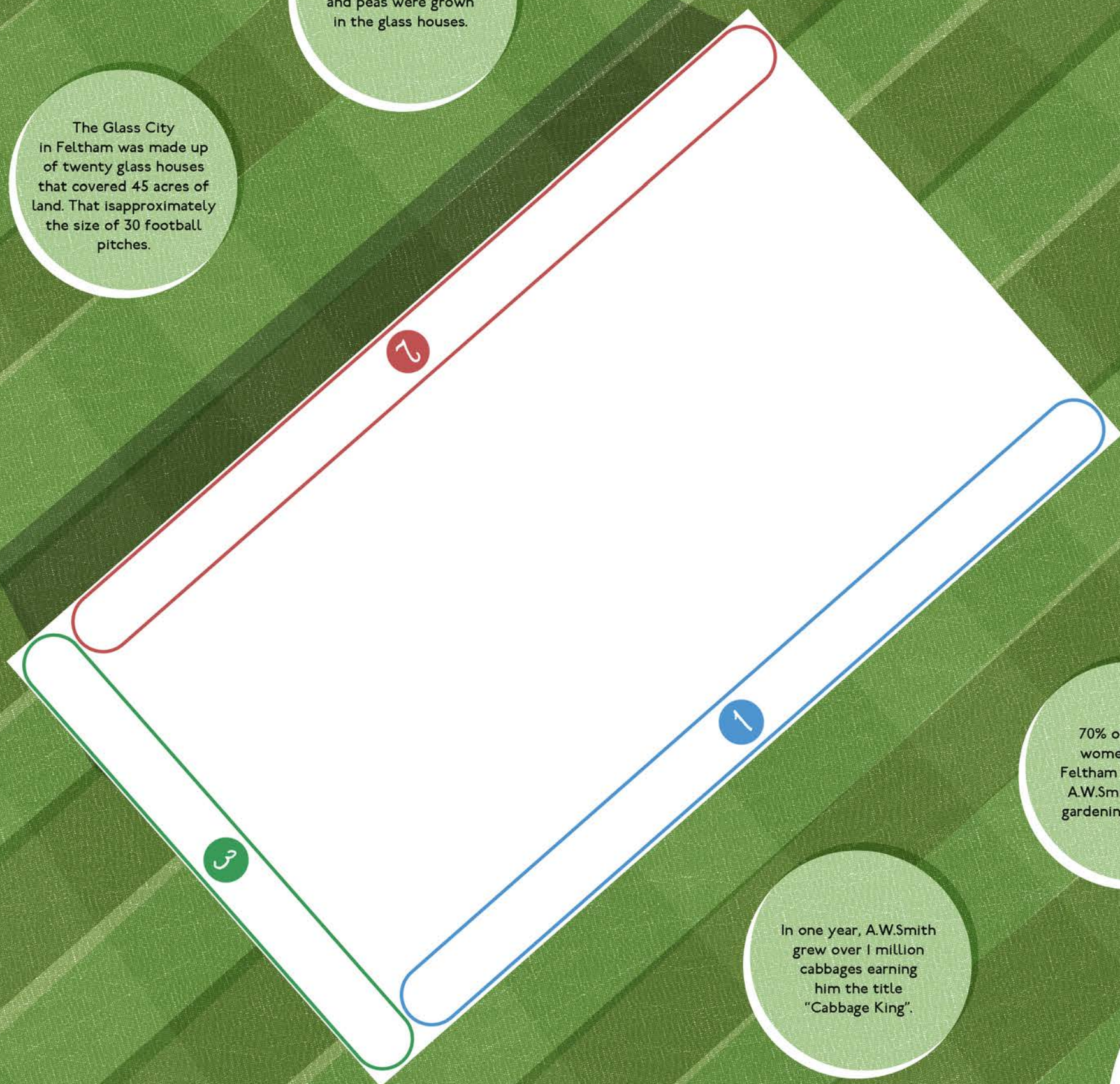
# GLASS CITY

Vast amounts of tomatoes, cabbages and peas were grown in the glass houses.

The Glass City in Feltham was made up of twenty glass houses that covered 45 acres of land. That is approximately the size of 30 football pitches.



70% of men and women living in Feltham were part of A.W.Smith's market gardening workforce.

In one year, A.W.Smith grew over 1 million cabbages earning him the title "Cabbage King".
