

# GRAF ZEPPELIN

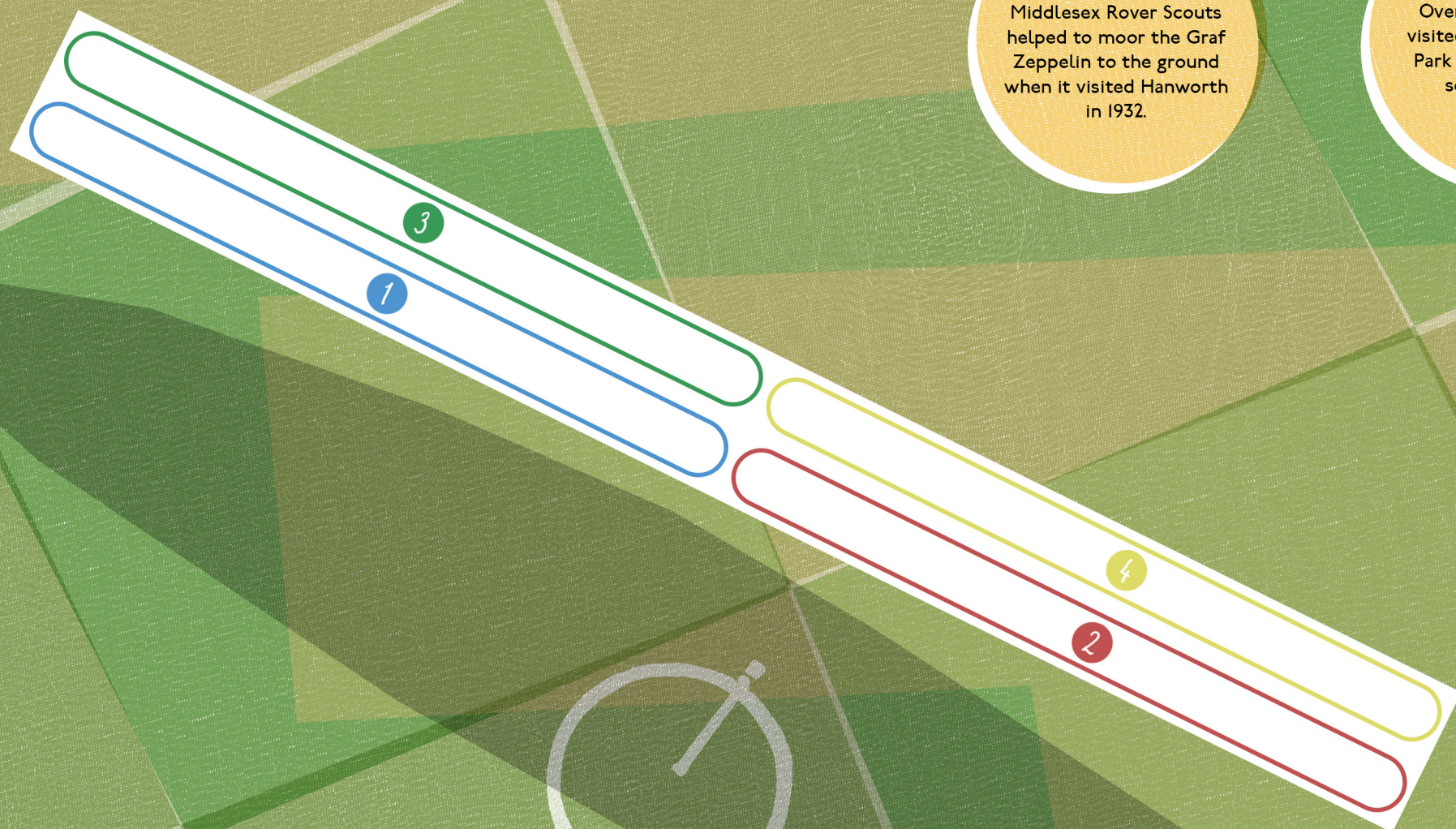
## LANDS AT HANWORTH

Two hundred Middlesex Rover Scouts helped to moor the Graf Zeppelin to the ground when it visited Hanworth in 1932.

Over 40,000 people visited the London Air Park at Hanworth, to see its arrival.

The airship made 590 flights and travelled over 1 million miles in it's nine years of operation.

The German built airship was scrapped in 1940 and the parts were used to make German fighter planes during the Second World War.
