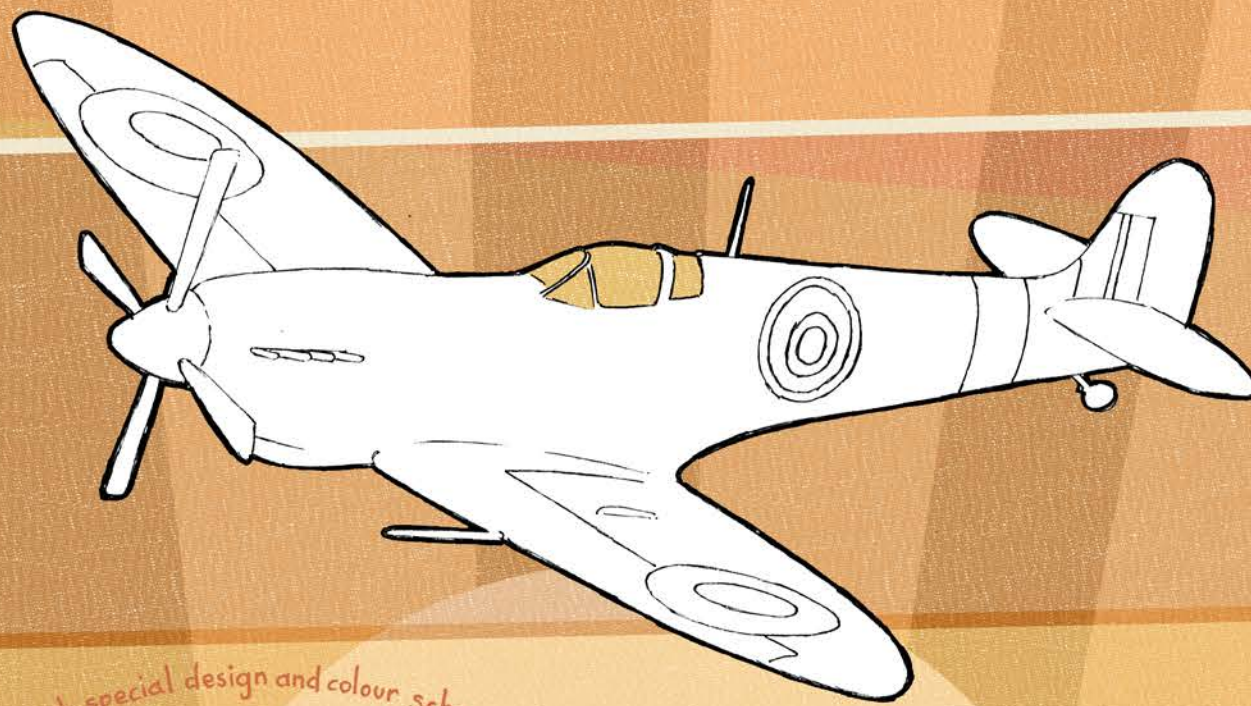


SPITFIRE

Supermarine Spitfire planes that were hit by enemy fire during the Second World War were fixed at General Aircraft Ltd in Hanworth.

The Supermarine Spitfire was classed as the fastest military air plane of it's time and could travel 342 miles per hour!

2160 Supermarine Spitfires had been built for the Royal Air Force by the time Britain was declared at war with Germany in 1939.

Four machine guns were fitted onto each wing of the plane. These eight guns were capable of firing 1000 rounds of bullets per minute to shoot down enemy bombers.
